


Instructions on Building Entry on Day 3 (Wednesday 03 July)

Where is the UCL Roberts/Engineering Front Building?



Day 3 of the Symposium will take place at [Roberts/Engineering Front Building](#) of University College London (Address: Malet Place, London, WC1E 7JE). It is within a 6-minute walk from Euston Square Station (Circle line) or Goodge Street (Northern line) Station, but also walkable from other stations. You can use [Journey Planner](#) to plan your journey.

How to enter the building?



Currently, restriction on entry to the campus is in place.

Please enter the building from the junction of Torrington Place and Malet Street.

Please bring your symposium name badge.

Is there a car park at UCL?

Sorry, we are situated in the city centre and there is no car parking space.

How can I bring my presentation file?

While UCL does not have a strict policy that prohibits access to UCL computers from USB memory sticks or any other device of an external user, we recommend that you send/upload your presentation file in the same way as Day 2.

Can I bring my luggage to UCL as I will go to an airport once it finishes?

Yes, you can bring. Luggage can be left at symposium venue in your own responsibility. As the venue is not spacious, if possible, it would be wise to keep your luggage in the hotel or somewhere.

Is there any power charging point in the room?

There are power charging points in the room, which you can use.

Is wi-fi available at UCL?

- If you are from an academic institution which uses [eduroam](#), you should be able to use this service using your ID and password for your institution.
- If you are from a UK public sector organisation, [govroam](#) is available across UCL.
- UCL also has a wi-fi for external users: [UCL Guest Wi-fi](#). Please note that this UCL Guest Wi-fi logs you off when the account is inactive for 15 minutes.
