

The Hollier Scholarship in Hebrew

Submissions are invited to the Hollier Scholarship in Hebrew until 15 September annually. The £1000 Hollier Scholarship in Hebrew was established in 1857 under the will of Richard Hollier.

Research (PhD) students in the field of Hebrew and Jewish Studies from across all Faculties at UCL are invited to apply for this scholarship by submitting

1. A three-page description of their research project including selected references (1.5 spaced, 11 point)
2. A one-page CV
3. A poster illustrating their project. Entries need to be submitted as electronic files

Please note re-entries are not permitted.

Applicants need to be registered as research students with a UCL Department at the time of application.

The Award Committee of the UCL Department for Hebrew and Jewish Studies will assess submissions for their scholarly potential alone. The Scholarship will be awarded by the UCL Faculty of Arts and Humanities.
