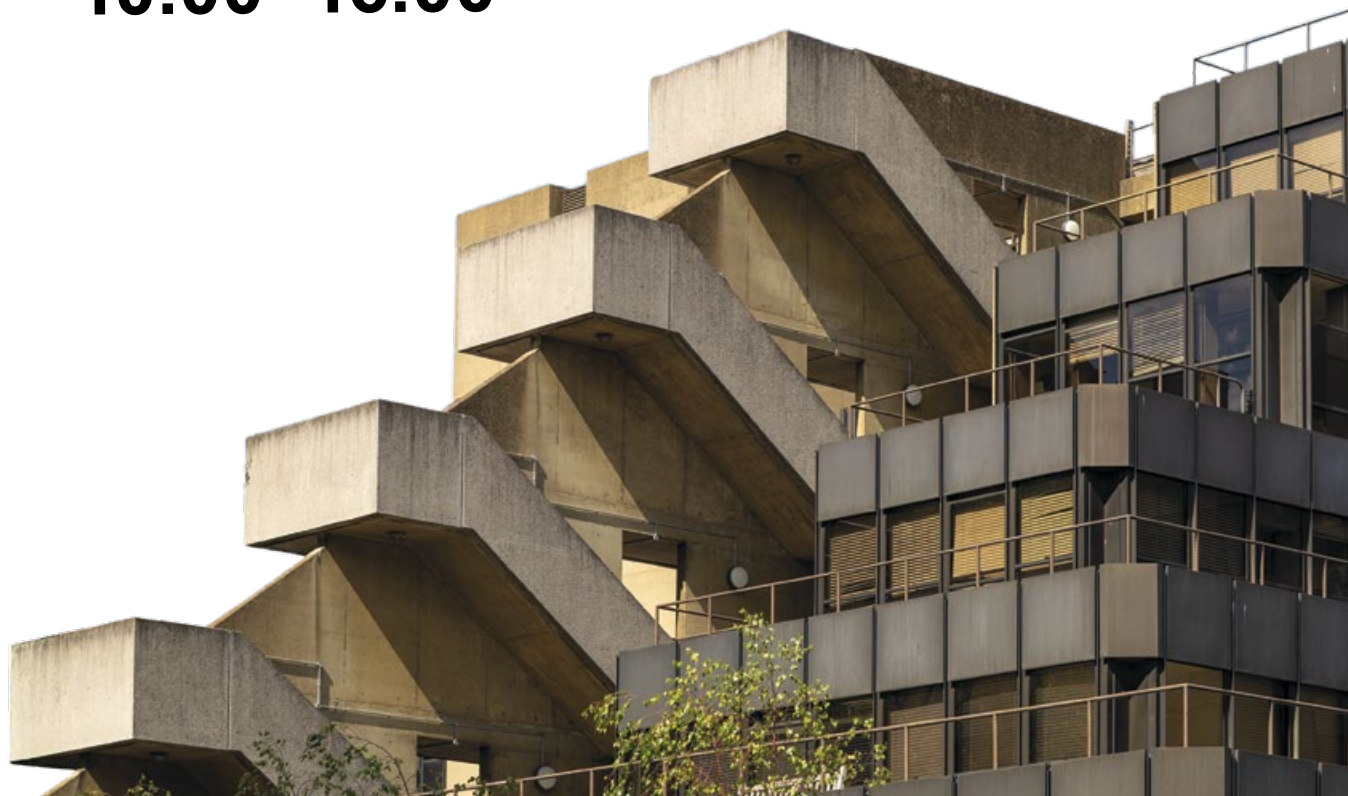

While you are on the Bloomsbury campus, I'm sure you will appreciate our wonderful location and all the benefits that brings.

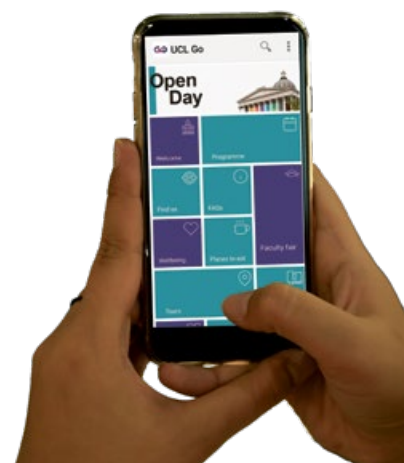
